IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to fix the Salary of the Judge of Probate for the County of Hancock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- SECTION 1. From and after the first day of
- 2 January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
- 3 hundred and ninety-one, the salary of the judge of
- 4 probate for the county of Hancock shall be eight
- 5 hundred dollars per year, instead of the sum now
- 6 fixed by law.
- Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
