RESOLVE in favor of helping maintain road from  
Patten to Crystal Plantation.

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appro-  
2 priated four hundred dollars to aid in maintaining  
3 the road leading from Patten Village in a southerly  
4 direction across Crystal Plantation to Sherman, the  
5 same to be expended under the direction of the  
6 county commissioners of Aroostook county.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Crystal Plantation is located in the western part of Aroostook county. The road for which the petitioners ask an appropriation runs for about six miles through unsettled land in said Crystal and is of no use or benefit thereto although maintained at great expense to said Crystal.
