STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT in relation to prosecutions for violations
of Municipal Ordinances and By-laws.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In a prosecution in any municipal
2 or police court for a violation of an ordinance or
3 by-law of a city or town, or of any by-law of a vil-
4 lage corporation or local board of health, it shall not
5 be necessary to recite such ordinance or by-law in
6 the complaint, or to allege the offence more particu-
7 larly than in prosecutions under a general statute.
