STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT providing for Granting Administration on the Estate of an Intestate more than twenty years after the death of the intestate, in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. When administration has not "been 2 taken on the estate of an intestate within twenty 3 years after the death of such intestate, and there-4 after any property of at least twenty dollars in 5 value, accrues to said estate or, belonging thereto, 6 first comes to the knowledge of any person inter-7 ested in said estate, original administration may

8 be granted on such property, at any time within 9 two years next after it so accrued or first became 10 known, but such administration shall affect no 11 other property, and shall not revive debts due to 12 or by said intestate.
