AN ACT to amend Section Ninety-seven of the School Laws of Maine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section ninety-seven of the school laws of Maine,

- 2 is hereby amended as follows: That after the word
- 3 "ruin" in the last line of said section it shall read:
- 4 'and it also shall be the duty of all teachers in the
- 5 public schools of this State to devote not less than
- 6 ten minutes of each week of the school term to
- 7 teaching to the children under their charge the
- 8 principle of kindness to birds and animals.'
