## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to provide for the election of a School Committee and Superintendent of Schools in the Town of Westbrook.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The school committee of the town of West-
- 2 brook shall consist of seven persons, to be elected at the
- 3 annual election of municipal officers, in the year of our
- 4 Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-one. At their first
- 5 meeting said committee shall designate by lot, two of
- 6 their number, who shall hold office for one year; and two
- 7 who shall hold office for two years; and three who shall
- 8 hold office for three years; and certify such designation
- 9 to the clerk of said town, to be by him recorded; and

- 10 thereafter at each annual municipal election in said town,
- 11 a person shall be elected to fill the place of each one whose
- 12 term expires, who shall hold office for three years.
- SECT. 2. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in said board,
- 2 the remaining members shall elect by ballot a person to fill
- 3 such vacancy, who shall hold office until the next annual
- 4 spring election, when the unexpired term, if any, shall be
- 5 filled by a person chosen at such election. No member of
- 6 the committee shall receive any compensation for his
- 7 services.
  - SECT. 3. The members of said committee duly elected,
  - 2 shall meet and organize on the second Monday in March,
  - 3 or as soon thereafter as may be. A majority of the board
  - 4 shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
  - 5 They shall have all the powers and perform all the duties
  - 6 in regard to the care and management of the public
  - 7 schools and school property of said town which are now
  - 8 conferred and imposed upon superintending school com-
  - 9 mittees and school agents, by the laws of this State, except
- 10 as otherwise provided in this act. They shall annually,
- 11 and whenever there is a vacancy, elect a superintendent
- 12 of schools, for the current municipal year, who shall have
- 13 the care and supervision of said public schools, under their
- 14 direction, and act as secretary of their board; they shall
- 15 fix his salary at the time of his election, which shall not
- 16 be increased nor diminished during the year for which he
- 17 is elected, and may at any time dismiss him, if they deem
- 18 it proper or expedient.
- Sect. 4. A suitable and convenient room shall be
- 2 furnished by the town for the meetings of said committee,
- 3 wherein shall be kept their records, open to the inspection
- 4 of the citizens of the town.

- SECT. 5. The said committee shall annually, before the
- 2 spring election, furnish to the selectmen of said town, an
- 3 estimate in detail of the several sums required during the
- 4 ensuing municipal year, for the support of said public
- 5 schools, and they shall not increase the expenditures beyond
- 6 the amount appropriated therefor.
- SECT. 6. All acts and parts of acts, inconsistent with
- 2 the provisions herein contained, as far as the town of
- 3 Westbrook is concerned are hereby repealed.
- SECT. 7. This act shall take effect when accepted by
- 2 the town of Westbrook.
