STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making an appropriation for repairs of
roads in Indian Township, Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred dollars
2 be and hereby is appropriated for the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-one, and the sum of four hun-
4 dred dollars for the year eighteen hundred and
5 ninety-two. All of which sums so appropriated are
6 to be expended under the direction of the county
7 commissioners of Washington county upon the
8 Houlton and Baring road and the road leading
9 from said Houlton and Baring road to Grand

10 Lake stream in Indian Township in Washington
11 county.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is asked for the purpose of keeping in repair the Houlton and Baring road, and the road leading from said Houlton and Baring road to Grand Lake stream, in Indian Township, in Washington county being twelve miles in length and a State road.

This road is the only line of communication between the northern and southern limits of the county, and is in very bad condition, from the fact that heavy teams pass daily over the road. Two daily mails pass twice each day over this route besides general travel.
