IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn Horse Railroad Company to use Electricity as a Motive Power.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Horse

- 2 Railroad Company is hereby authorized and em-
- 3 powered to use electricity as a motive power for
- 4 propelling its street cars over and upon its lines of
- 5 track, as now constructed and hereafter to be ex-
- 6 tended, within the cities of Lewiston and Auburn.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
