STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section eleven of chapter eighteen
of the Revised Statutes, relating to Ways.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section 11, chapter 18, of the Re-
vised Statutes is hereby amended by adding
thereto the following words: 'If any appeal for
increase of damages is taken, and the commis-
sioners are of opinion that their proceedings
hereunder, or any part thereof, ought not to take
effect, they shall enter a judgment that the prayer
of the original petitioners, or any part thereof,

) designating what part, is not granted for that
10 reason. Upon such judgment no damages shall
11 be allowed for that part of the prayer of the peti-
12 tioners not granted, but the costs shall be paid by
13 the county; and this shall apply to proceedings in
14 which any such appeal is now pending.'
