STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize Bangor Street Railway to extend its System.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Bangor Street Railway is hereby 2 authorized to lay and maintain its rails, set poles, 3 and place wires, and operate its cars upon the 4 streets within the towns of Hampden, Orrington 5 and Veazie, or any of said towns, the license of the 6 municipal officers of such town or towns to occupy 7 such streets for such purposes having been first 8 obtained.

- SECT. 2. Said Bangor Street Railway may issue 2 additional stock, and its bonds secured by a mort-3 gage or mortgages of such additional track, equip-4 ments, poles, wires, and other additional property 5 as may be necessary.
- SECT. 3. If the Old Town, Orono and Veazie 2 Railway shall fail to construct its line of railway 3 from Old Town to the junction of Main and Olive 4 streets in the town of Veazie within two years from 5 the approval of this act, then said Bangor Street 6 Railway is authorized to extend its railway with all 7 the privileges granted in the act incorporating said 8 Old Town, Orono and Veazie Railway.
- Sect. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
