STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Frontier Telephone and Telegraph Compay.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. E. L. Houghton, Nicholas Fessenden, E.

- 2 W. Gowing, C. P. Allen and M. N. Drew, their asso-
- 3 ciates, successors and assigns, are hereby created a body
- 4 politic by the name of the Frontier Telephone and Tele-
- 5 graph Company, with all the powers, rights and privi-
- 6 leges, and subject to all the duties and obligations granted
- 7 and prescribed by the general laws of this State, relating
- 8 to corporations. Said corporation shall have the right to
- 9 locate, construct, maintain and operate lines of telephone
- 10 and telegraph from some point in the town of Fort Fair-

- 11 field, through Limestone, Caribou, Washburn, Mapleton,
- 12 Presque Isle, Easton, Castle Hill, Sheridan and Ashland.
 - SECT. 2. Said company shall have the right within the
- 2 limits aforesaid, to locate, construct and maintain and
- 3 operate its lines upon any public way, bridge or private
- 4 lands, but in such a manner as not to incommode or en-
- 5 danger the customary use of such way, road or bridge,
- 6 with the right to cut down trees, remove obstacles where
- 7 necessary within the limits aforesaid, except ornamental,
- 8 fruit or shade trees, and with the power to establish and
- 9 collect tolls on said line.
- Sect. 3. If the land of any individual or corporation is
- 2 taken under this act and the parties cannot agree on the
- 3 damages occasioned thereby, they shall be estimated,
- 4 secured and paid in the manner provided in case of land
- 5 taken for railroads.
- Sect. 4. The amount of capital stock shall be fixed by
- 2 vote of the corporation, but not to exceed the amount that
- 3 may from time to time be necessary for the purposes herein
- 4 specified, but not to exceed ten thousand dollars, and said
- 5 corporation may purchase, hold, sell and convey real estate
- 6 and personal property necessary for the purposes contem-
- 7 plated in this chapter.
- Sect. 5. Any one of the corporators named in this act
- 2 may call the first meeting of this company, by mailing a
- 3 written notice to each of the other corporators, seven days
- 4 at least before the day of meeting, naming the time, place
- 5 and purposes of such meeting; and at such meeting a presi-
- 6 dent, secretary, treasurer and directors may be chosen,
- 7 by-laws adopted, and any corporate business transacted.
 - Sect. 6. This act shall take effect when approved.
