STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE making appropriations for the Passama-
quoddy Tribe of Indians.

Resolved, That there be paid from the State
2 treasury to be expended under the direction of the
3 governor and council, to the agent of the Passa-
4 maquoddy tribe of Indians, for the benefit of said
5 tribe, for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-
6 one and eighteen hundred and ninety-two, as fol-
7 lows: For May dividends, five hundred dollars
8 each year; for distressed and contingent poor,
9 three thousand and two hundred dollars each year;
10 for November dividends, five hundred dollars each

11 year; for bounty on crops, two hundred dollars
12 each year; for ploughing, one hundred and fifty
13 dollars each year; for salary of governor, one hun-
14 dred dollars each year; for salary of lieutenant
15 governor, forty dollars each year; for fuel, five
16 hundred dollars each year; for contingent pur-
17 poses, one hundred and fifty dollars each year; for
18 salary of priests, two hundred dollars each year;
19 for dressing of land, one hundred and fifty dollars
20 each year; for agricultural purposes, six hundred
21 dollars each year; for salary of agent, two hun-
22 dred dollars each year; for basket ash, one hun-
23 dred dollars each year; for repairing schoolhouse
24 at Pleasant Point, two hundred and fifty dollars to
25 be expended in eighteen hundred and ninety-one;
26 for repairing church at same place, one hundred
27 and fifty dollars, to be expended in eighteen hun-
28 dred and ninety-one, and for repairing town hall at
29 the same place, one hundred dollars, to be expended
30 in eighteen hundred and ninety-one, the same to
31 be expended under the direction of the agent and
32 resident priest.

All the foregoing sums to be expended under the
34 direction of the governor and council for the pur-
35 poses for which they are appropriated, and for none
36 other, and any sums of money not expended for

37 the purpose for which it is appropriated shall not
38 be allowed to said agent in the settlement of his
39 account.
