IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Lewiston and Auburn
Horse Railroad Company to use Electricity as a
Motive Power.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

SECTION 1. The Lewiston and Auburn Horse
2 Railroad Company is hereby authorized and em-
3 powered to use electricity as a motive power for
4 propelling its street cars over and upon its lines of
5 track as now constructed and hereafter to be con-

6 structured, within the cities of Lewiston and Auburn,
7 first obtaining the consent of the municipal officers
8 of said cities, and subject to such terms and condi-
9 tions as the cities of Lewiston and Auburn may
10 impose.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-
2 proved.
