STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT relating to the salary of the County Commissioners of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. From and after the first day of 2 April in the year of our Lord one thousand, eight 3 hundred and ninety-one; the compensation of each 4 of the county commissioners of the county of Cum-5 berland shall be a salary, to wit: the chairman shall 6 receive the sum of nine hundred dollars, and each

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7 of the other commissioners shall receive the sum of 8 eight hundred dollars annually, payable from the 9 county treasury in quarterly payments, on the first 10 days of January, April, July and October, in full 11 for all services, expenses and travel, including the 12 management of the jail work-shop and the sale of 13 its products; at least a majority of said board shall 14 be in attendance at their office in Portland on all 15 secular days except when official business calls 16 them elsewhere.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts conflicting 2 with this act are hereby repealed.
