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STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT in relation to the Municipal Court of the  
City of Portland.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The salaries of the judge and  
2 recorder of the municipal court for the city of  
3 Portland shall be paid out of the treasury of the  
4 county of Cumberland, and all moneys, fines, costs,  
5 court fees of every nature and proceeds from for-

6 feitures received by the recorder of said court, and  
7 all fees, fines and moneys accruing from said  
8 court paid to the jailor after commitment shall be  
9 accounted for by them respectively and paid over  
10 to the treasurer of said county quarterly; except-  
11 ing, however, that all fines and proceeds of forfeit-  
12 ures received by the recorder by reason of the  
13 violation of any ordinance of the city of Portland  
14 shall be paid over to the treasurer of said city of  
15 Portland by him.

SECT. 2. It shall be the duty of the county com-  
2 missioners to furnish and provide at the expense  
3 of the county all blanks required for the use of said  
4 court in the transaction of its civil and criminal  
5 business, including proper books for the record of  
6 all cases arising in said court.

And said commissioner shall also provide, at the  
8 expense of said county, necessary office stationery  
9 and supplies for the use of the judge and recorder  
10 of said court in the performance of their official  
11 duties.

SECT. 3. The salary of the judge of said court  
2 shall be twelve hundred dollars per annum, payable  
3 quarterly, in full for all services.

SECT. 4. All acts or parts of acts conflicting  
2 with this act are hereby repealed.

SECT. 5. This act shall go into effect on the first  
2 day of April, A. D. 1891.
