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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend Section 6 of Chapter 111 of  
the Revised Statutes relating to Assignments of  
Wages.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section six of chapter one hundred and eleven of  
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding  
3 thereto the following: 'And no such assignment  
4 of wages shall be valid against the employer, unless  
5 he has actual notice thereof,' so that said section  
6 as amended shall read as follows:

‘No assignment of wages is valid against any  
8 other person than the parties thereto, unless  
9 such assignment is recorded by the clerk of the  
10 city, town or plantation organized for any purpose,  
11 in which the assignor is commorant, while earning  
12 such wages; and the clerk’s fee shall be twenty-  
13 five cents. And no such assignment of wages  
14 shall be valid against the employer unless he has  
15 actual notice thereof.’
