IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend Section 20, Chapter 30 of
the Revised Statutes, relating to the killing of
Muskrat.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section twenty of chapter thirty of the Revised
2 Statutes is hereby amended as follows: By strik-
3 ing out after the word fisher, the words "muskrat,"
4 and inserting the following 'or whoever destroys
5 any muskrat between the twentieth day of May and

6 the first day of March,' so that said section as
7 amended shall read:

‘Section 1. Whoever, between the first day of
9 May and the fifteenth day of October destroys any
10 mink, beaver; sable, otter, fisher, or whoever de-
11 stroys any muskrat between the twentieth day of
12 May and the first day of March, forfeits ten dollars
13 for each animal so destroyed, to be recovered on
14 complaint.’
