IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT entitled "An Act to exempt Little River
in Perry from the provisions of Chapter 40, Revised
Statutes, so far as it applies to fish-ways."

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Little river in Perry, Maine, shall be exempt from
2 all the provisions of chapter 40, Revised Statutes,
3 that relate to maintaining fish-ways in said river,
4 except April, May and June.
