## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of Fish from Bunganeaut Pond in Towns of Alfred and Lyman.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. All persons are hereby prohibited

- 2 from taking or catching any fish from Bunganeaut
- 3 pond, situated in the towns of Alfred and Lyman,
- 4 in the county of York from the first day of Novem-
- 5 ber to the first day of June following in each year.

SECT. 2. All persons are forbidden to take fish

- 2 of any kind from said pond in any other way than
- 3 by hook and line.

SECT. 3. Any person who shall violate the pro-

- 2 visions of this act shall pay the sum of five dollars
- 3 (\$5.00) for each fish taken, to be recovered on com-
- 4 plaint before any trial justice in said county of York,
- 5 one-half to the use of the complainant and the other
- 6 half to the use of said county.
