STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to fix the salaries of the warden and clerk of the State Prison.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. From and after the first day of

- 2 December, 1890, the salary of the warden of the
- 3 State Prison shall be eighteen hundred dollars per
- 4 year, with the use, without charge, of such part of
- 5 the keeper's house and buildings of the State,
- 6 appurtenant to the prison and yard, as the gov-
- 7 ernor and council may direct, and fuel for his own
- 8 use, which shall be in full for all services, includ-

- 9 ing the duty of receiving and paying out money
- 10 for all purposes. From and after the first day of
- 11 December, 1890, the salary of the clerk of the
- 12 State Prison shall be, not exceeding one thou-
- 13 sand dollars per year.

SECT. 2. This act shall be in force after ap-2 proval.
