## STATE OF MAINE.

**RESOLVE** in favor of the town of Passadumkeag.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appro-2 priated the sum of four hundred dollars, to be 3 expended under the direction of the county com-4 missioners of the county of Penobscot, to repair the 5 bridge over the Passadumkeag stream, in the town 6 of Passadumkeag, on the military road from Ban-7 gor to Houlton. . . .

### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Passadumkeag is a small town in the county of Penobscot, having a valuation of only a little over thirty thousand dollars. The bridge across the Passadumkeag stream is on a main thoroughfare from Bangor to Houlton and is in need of considerable repair, more than the citizens and tax payers of the town can reasonably be called upon to make.
