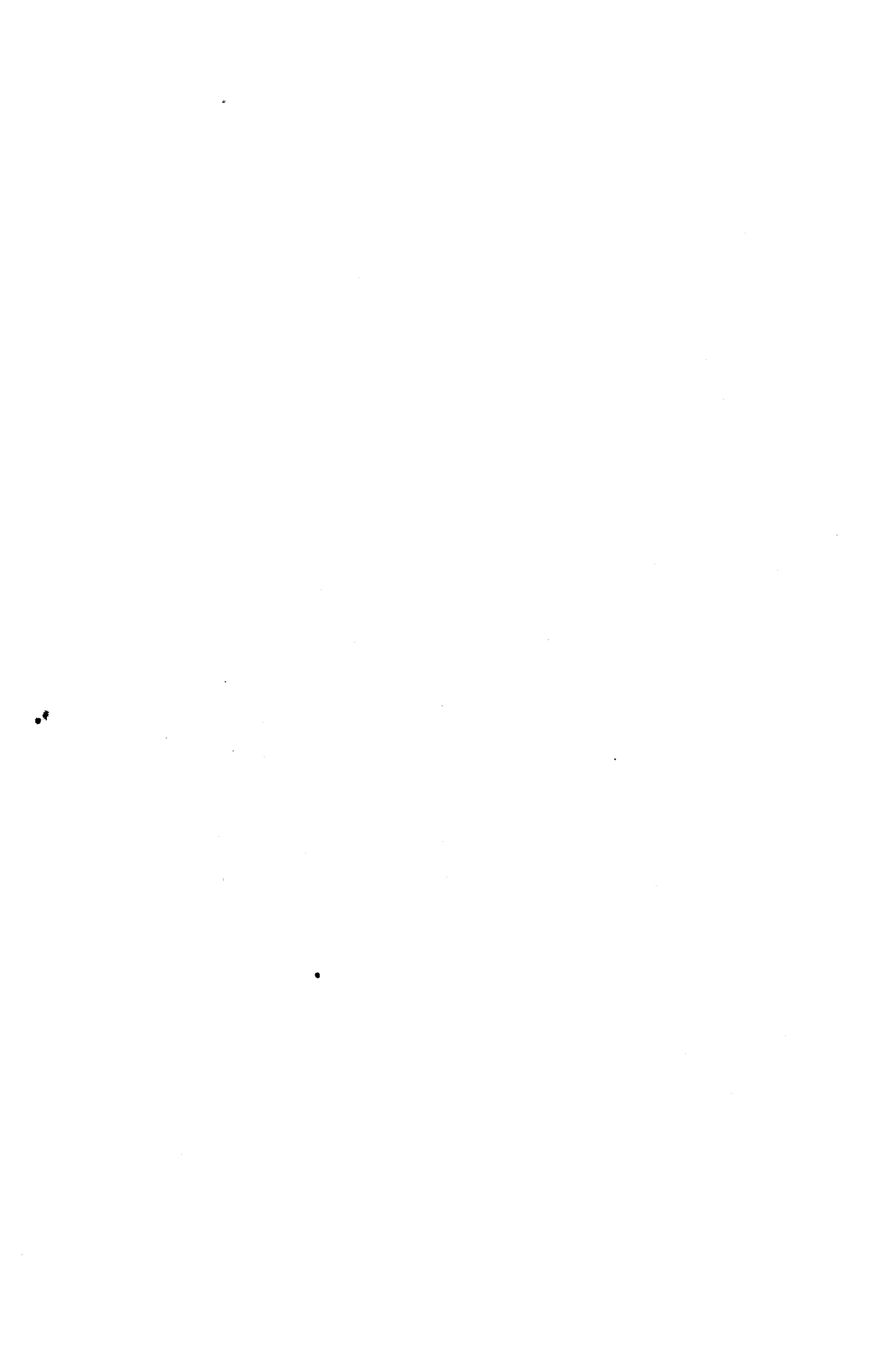

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the town of Passadumkeag.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of four hundred dollars, to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of the county of Penobscot, to repair the bridge over the Passadumkeag stream, in the town of Passadumkeag, on the military road from Bangor to Houlton.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Passadumkeag is a small town in the county of Penobscot, having a valuation of only a little over thirty thousand dollars. The bridge across the Passadumkeag stream is on a main thoroughfare from Bangor to Houlton and is in need of considerable repair, more than the citizens and tax payers of the town can reasonably be called upon to make.
