## STATEMENT OF FACTS

TO ACCOMPANY HOUSE DOCUMENT No. 194.

Rufas K. Merrill of Springfield, Capt. of Co. I, 6th Regiment Infantry 1st Brigade, 3d Division. Commissioned to rank from Aug. 17, 1838. In 1839, by orders of General Samuel F. Hersey he spent 18 days in actual service of the State in getting his troops together to start for Aroostook, afterwards was ordered to search out and bring in the missing men, and to purchase lead, and run bullets. He spent \$13.50 traveling expenses ; eighteen days labor at \$2 per day, \$36.00 ; five days in running bullets at \$2 per day, \$10.00 ; making a total of \$59.50, for which he never received any pay for from the State.
