STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to prevent the use of narrow rimmed wheels for the hauling of freight or merchandise over the streets of the city of Calais.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. No person or persons shall haul any 2 freight or merchandise over the streets of the city 3 of Calais with a team of three or more horses, mules

- 4 or oxen upon wheels of less than six inches tread or
- 5 breadth of rim.

Sect. 2. Any person violating the provisions of 2 the foregoing section shall pay a fine of ten dollar-

- 3 for each offense with costs of prosecution, to be
- 4 recovered on complaint of any city officer of said
- 5 Calais before the municipal court of said city, and
- 6 all fines collected under this act shall forthwith be
- 7 paid into the treasury of said city.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in
- 2 force from and after the first day in the year of our
- 3 Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.
