## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

---

AN ACT to prevent the use of narrow rimmed  
wheels for the hauling of freight or merchandise  
over the streets of the city of Calais.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall haul any  
2 freight or merchandise over the streets of the city  
3 of Calais with a team of three or more horses, mules  
4 or oxen upon wheels of less than six inches tread or  
5 breadth of rim.

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of  
2 the foregoing section shall pay a fine of ten dollars

3 for each offense with costs of prosecution, to be  
4 recovered on complaint of any city officer of said  
5 Calais before the municipal court of said city, and  
6 all fines collected under this act shall forthwith be  
7 paid into the treasury of said city.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect and be in  
2 force from and after the first day in the year of our  
3 Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.
