STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Delegates to Farmers
National Congress.

Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid
2 out of the treasury of the State the sum of four
3 hundred dollars (\$400) from which shall be paid
4 in part payment for the expenses of four delegates
5 whom the governor may appoint to represent the
6 State of Maine at the National Farmers Congress
7 to be held in the State of Missouri the present
8 year; and a like sum for the year 1892, bills for
9 the same to be audited by the governor and coun-
10 cil—Maine being entitled to said number of
11 delegates.
