RESOLVE in favor of Codyville Plantation,  
Washington County.

---

*Resolved,* That the State treasurer is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to refund to Codyville  
3 plantation, Washington county, the sum of sixty-  
4 six dollars. The same being an amount of State  
5 tax overpaid by said plantation by mistake for the  
6 years eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, eighteen  
7 hundred and eighty-eight and eighteen hundred  
8 and eighty-nine.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation has been asked for as a rebate of the amount of State tax actually overpaid by the plantation of Codyville during the years of 1887, 1888 and 1889. The overpay is due to the fact that said plantation has been taxed with 8000 acres of wild land more than is really within the boundaries of said plantation.
