AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Thomaston Street Railway  
Company to extend its railroad to Warren and St.  
George.

---

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The Thomaston Street Railway  
2 Company is hereby authorized to construct, operate  
3 and maintain a street railroad from Wyllie's Corner,  
4 in the town of St. George, thence over the county  
5 road to the boundary line of Thomaston, subject to  
6 all the restrictions and limitations of its existing

7 charter, and with all the powers and privileges  
8 thereby conferred.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-  
2 proved.
