IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to authorize the Thomaston Street Railway Company to extend its railroad to Warren and St. George.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Thomaston Street Railway

- 2 Company is hereby authorized to construct, operate
- 3 and maintain a street railroad from Wyllie's Corner,
- 4 in the town of St. George, thence over the county
- 5 road to the boundary line of Thomaston, subject to
- 6 all the restrictions and limitations of its existing

7 charter, and with all the powers and privileges 8 thereby conferred.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when ap-2 proved.
