STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the New Sharon Cemetery Improvement Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. H. B. Prescott, Z. A. Dyer, W. W. Nor-

- 2 cross, Rosetta A. Curtis, James W. Smith, Frederic
- 3 Swan, Jabez S. Mooers, Chas. W. Thompson and Horace
- 4 Soule, their associates and successors are hereby consti-
- 5 tuted a body corporate under the name of New Sharon
- 6 Cemetery Improvement Association and under that name
- 7 shall have power to prosecute and defend suits at law,
- 8 take and hold for the objects of their association, by gift,
- 9 grant, bequest, purchase or otherwise, any estate, real or

- 10 personal, and to sell and convey the same as the interests11 of the said association may require.
- SECT. 2. Having accepted any donation or legacy, said 2 association as trustee shall be legally bound to perform the 3 duties specified in the writing creating the trust, or as 4 required by law, if not so specified, and as in cases of pub-5 lic charity.
- SECT. 3. All trust funds authorized by this act shall be 2 safely invested in legal securities and depositories and the 3 annual income only shall be expended in the performance 4 of the requirements of the trust unless otherwise designated.
- SECT. 4. The first meeting of said association shall be 2 called by any two persons named in the first section of 3 this act, by giving each person named in the act a notice 4 in writing at least seven days before said meeting. Said 5 notice shall state the time and place and purposes of said 6 meeting. Such officers shall be chosen and such other 7 proceedings had for a full and complete organization, as a 8 majority of the members may determine, and such by-laws 9 adopted as may be necessary and not inconsistent with 10 the laws of the State.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.
