STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend the charter of the Castine Railway and Navigation Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Castine Railway and Navigation Com-

- 2 pany after it shall have taken a lease or conveyance of the
- 3 franchise, corporate rights and other property of the
- 4 Penobscot Central Railroad Company may issue its own
- 5 bonds for the purpose of raising funds with which to build
- 6 and equip a railroad from Castine in the county of Han-
- 7 cock to Milo Junction in the county of Piscataquis, and

- 8 secure said bonds by a joint mortgage, in its own name,
- 9 of the franchises, corporate rights and other properties of
- 10 both said railroads, and may construct, maintain and
- 11 operate a telephone and telegraph line along the lines of
- 12 said roads and the branches thereof, and with the power
- 13 to establish and collect tolls on said line or lines.

SECT. 2. Said Castine Railway and Navigation Com-

- 2 pany is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with
- 3 the State of Maine for the transportation over its railroad,
- 4 so far as constructed, and over the lines of railroad which
- 5 it may lease or purchase, of troops and munitions of war,
- 6 in times of war, insurrection or civil commotion, free of
- 7 charge other than as herein provided, for a period of
- 8 twenty years from and after the passage of this act, and
- 9 to receive therefor from said State, annually, for the term
- 10 of said contract, an amount which shall equal ninety-five
- 11 per cent of the taxes collected in the corresponding year
- 12 by said State from said corporation, upon its road and
- 13 other real and personal property including its stock and
- 14 franchises, and also including that purchased or leased or
- 15 in which it may acquire an interest under its charter.
- 16 Whenever such a contract shall be executed by said cor-
- 17 poration and approved by a majority vote of its stock-
- 18 holders at a meeting duly called for that purpose, and
- 19 shall be presented to the treasurer of said State, it shall
- 20 be the duty of said treasurer to execute said contract in
- 21 behalf of said State, and thereafter said treasurer shall
- 22 pay over to said corporation, each year during the term
- 23 of said contract, the amount provided in this section.
 - SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
