STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the Long Island Railroad Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Edward P. Chase, George F. Gould, Napo-

- 2 leon B. Chase, Richard K. Gatley, Benjamin W. Storer
- 3 and Herbert G. Briggs all of Portland, in the county of
- 4 Cumberland, their successors and assigns, are hereby con-
- 5 stituted a corporation by the name of Long Island Rail-
- 6 road Company, with authority to construct, maintain and
- 7 operate a railroad, either by steam, horse-power or elec-
- 8 tricity, for the carriage of freight and passengers around
- 9 the shore of Long Island, in Portland Harbor, from a
- 10 point at or near the steamboat wharf and around the shore

- 11 of said island to the starting point, over the streets on
- 12 said island, subject to the consent of the municipal officers
- 13 of said city of Portland, or over private property with
- 14 authority to take all necessary property, with all the
- 15 rights and privileges and subject to all the duties and
- 16 liabilities of the laws of this State.
- Sect. 2. The capital stock of said corporation shall not
- 2 exceed fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of
- 3 one hundred dollars each, and no share shall be issued for
- 4 less than its par value.
- Sect. 3. Said corporation shall have power to purchase
- 2 and hold such real estate as may be necessary or convenient
- 3 for the purposes of said railroad.
- Sect. 4. Said corporation or their directors may, from
- 2 time to time, determine what parts of their railroad they
- 3 desire to operate, and at what portions of the year they
- 4 desire to operate the same, and they shall not be holden to
- 5 operate the whole or any portion thereof for more than six
- 6 months of any one year.
- Sect. 5. Said corporation is hereby authorized to issue
- , 2 bonds for the purpose of constructing its railroad, or for
 - 3 money which it may borrrow for any purposes sanctioned
 - 4 by law. Said bonds to be issued in sums of not less than
 - 5 one hundred dollars each, payable in not more than twenty
 - 6 years from this date, with interest payable semi-annually.
 - SECT. 6. This act shall be void unless said railroad shall
 - 2 be completed, or in process of construction, on or before
 - 3 the first day of November, A. D. 1893.
 - Sect. 7. Nothing in this act shall deprive the legisla-2 ture of the right to alter, amend or repeal this charter.
 - SECT. 8. This act shall take effect when approved.
