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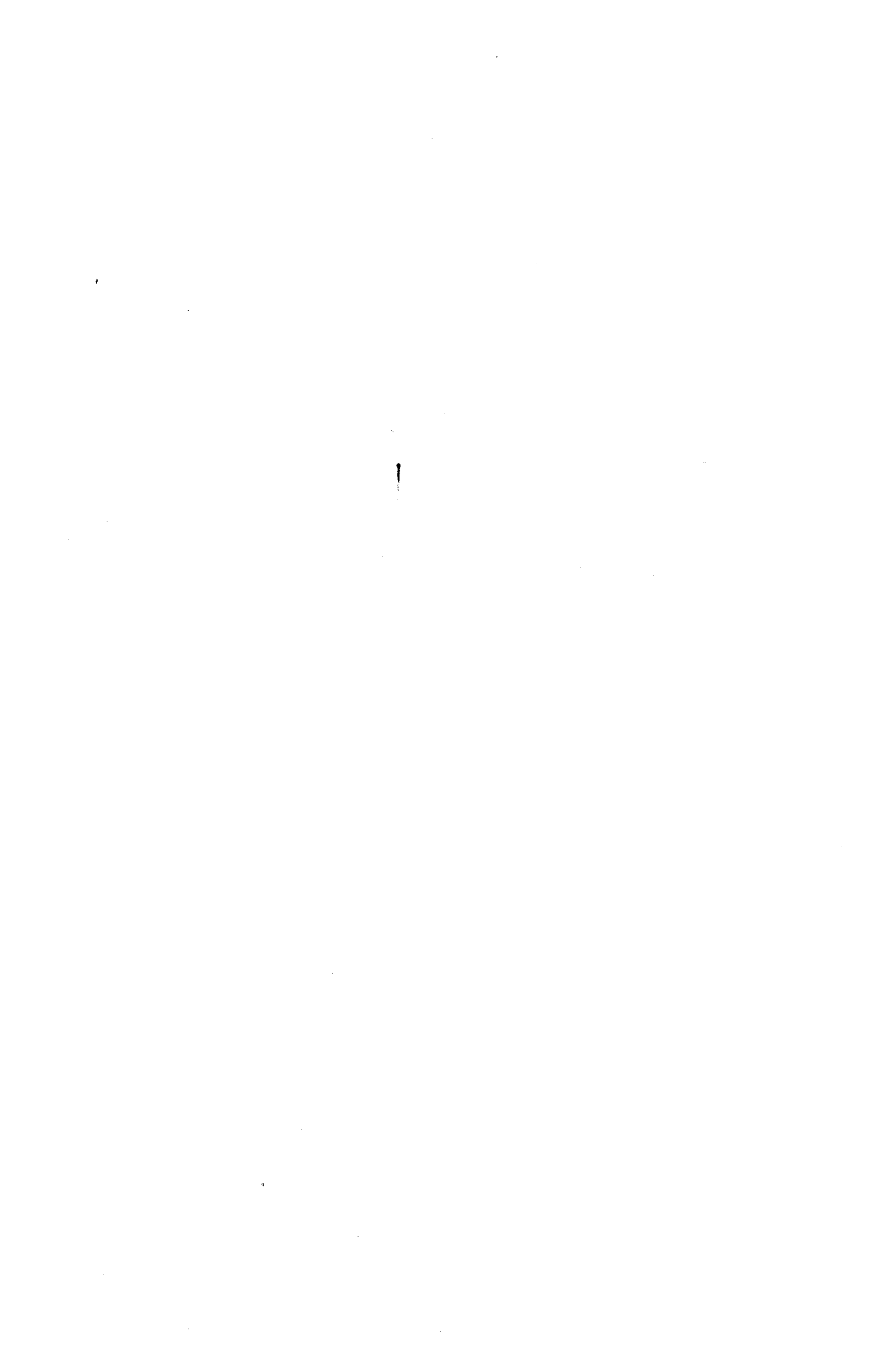
AN ACT to amend chapter seventy of the Revised Statutes,  
relating to the Insolvent Law.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. In all cases wherein the insolvent estate is  
2 insufficient to pay the fees and expense of the court and its  
3 officers, the judge in his discretion may order the petitioner  
4 at any time during the pendency of the proceedings, upon  
5 petition of any party interested, to deposit a specified sum  
6 of money with the register to be used in payment of the  
7 expense of the insolvent proceedings; and, upon the fail-  
8 ure of the insolvent to comply with the order of court, the  
9 judge may order the proceedings dismissed.

SECT. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with the  
2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
