STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of Dyer Brook.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The township now comprising the planta-
2 tion of Dyer Brook, being township number five, range
3 four, west from the east line of the State, in the county of
4 Aroostook with the inhabitants thereof is hereby incor-
5 porated into a town by the name of Dyer Brook with all
6 the powers and subject to all the duties of incorporated
7 towns in this State.

SECT. 2. The assessors of said Dyer Brook plantation
2 are hereby authorized and required to call the first meet-
3 ing of said town under this act for the choice of town offi-
4 cers by issuing their warrant for the same seven days

5 prior to the time of said meeting which shall be holden
6 within thirty days after the date of the approval of this act.

SECT. 3. The town hereby created shall be possessed of
2 all the property and effects belonging to said plantation
3 and shall assume all the liabilities thereof.

SECT. 4. This act shall take effect when approved.
