## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section forty-six of chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the Revised Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:


Section 1. Section forty-six of chapter one hundred

- 2 and twenty-four of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended
- 3 by striking out the words "officer or agent thereof in the
- 4 State" and adding after the words "can do" the words
- 5 'and whose jurisdiction shall extend throughout the State,'
- 6 so that the section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 46. Upon application by the mayor and alder-

- 8 men of any city, the selectmen of any town, or the president
- 9 and three directors of any such society, the governor and

- 10 council shall issue a badge and commission to any person
- 11 designated, to arrest any person charged with violating
- 12 any of the preceding seventeen sections, the same as any
- 13 sheriff, deputy sheriff or constable can do, and whose
- 14 jurisdiction shall extend throughout the State.'
  - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
