STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of certain settlers occupying lands in the
Madawaska Territory affected by the Treaty of Wash-
ington.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated out
2 of the state treasury the sum of fifty dollars and thirty-five
3 cents, to be paid by warrants drawn by the governor and
4 council, to the persons hereinafter named as follows :

To Thomas Cota for Mary Yearington, heir of Isaac
6 Yearington, or her heirs or assigns, the sum of thirty-
7 seven dollars and seventy-one cents.

To Wm. Dickey, agent for Chas. Bouchard, or his heirs
9 or assigns, the sum of twelve dollars and sixty-four cents.

The said sums hereby appropriated are for the purpose of
11 carrying out the provisions of chapter 220 of the resolves
12 of 1889, said sums having lapsed into the state treasury
13 before the papers in the above named cases could be
14 prepared.
