STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to prohibit the taking of trout from Demuth
Meadow brook and Willett Meadow brook in the town of
Waldoboro'.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. All persons are prohibited from taking or
2 catching trout in Demuth Meadow brook and Willett
3 Meadow brook in the town of Waldoboro' anywhere south
4 of the road leading from Waldoboro' village to Union, to
5 where said brooks empty into the Medomak river, includ-

6 ing all streams flowing into said brooks between said road
7 and said river, for the term of five years.

SECT. 2. Any person convicted of violation of this act
2 shall be punished by fine of ten dollars and costs of prose-
3 cution, one-half of said fine to be paid the complainant and
4 one-half to the county of Lincoln.
