STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend section one, chapter three hundred forty-three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, relating to the taking of fish from Spectacle Ponds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECTION 1. Section one of chapter three hundred forty-
2 three of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hun-
3 dred and eighty-nine, is amended by adding after the
4 word "year" in the fourth line thereof, the words 'and
5 also from the tributaries of said ponds for a term of three
6 years and thereafter between the first day of November

7 and the tenth day of June following, in each year,' so that
8 said section, as amended, shall read as follows :

'Section 1. All persons are prohibited hereby to take
10 fish of any kind from the Spectacle ponds, so called, in
11 the town of Porter, in the county of Oxford, between the
12 first day of November and the tenth day of June following,
13 in each year ; and also from the tributaries of said ponds
14 for a term of three years and thereafter between the first
15 day of November and the tenth day of June following,
16 in each year.'

SECT. 2. Any person violating the provisions of this
2 act, shall, on conviction of the same before any trial justice
3 in Oxford county, forfeit the sum of ten dollars, one-half
4 to the complainant, and one-half to the county of Oxford.
