RESOLVE in favor of Cary Plantation.

---

*Resolved,* That the sum of four hundred dollars be  
2 hereby appropriated to aid in building a bridge across the  
3 Meduxnekeag stream, Cary Plantation, Aroostook county,  
4 and that said appropriation be expended under the super-  
5 vision of the county commissioners of Aroostook county.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Plantation of Cary had in 1880 a valuation of about \$20,000 is sparsely settled and has not increased rapidly in wealth since 1880. They have five bridges and about thirty miles of road to maintain. There is immediate necessity for building a bridge over the Meduxnekeag river on the main road to Hodgdon and towns north and that as at present situated, the plantation is not able to bear the whole expense. Estimated cost of bridge \$800.
