## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and three of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, relating to Labor.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Chapter three hundred and three of the Public Laws of 2 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is hereby amended so 3 as to read as follows:

- 'Any employer, employee, or other person who by
- 5 threats of injury, intimidation or force, alone or in combi-
- 6 nation with others, prevents any person from entering
- 7 into, continuing in, or leaving the employment of any
- 8 person, firm or corporation, shall be punished by impris-
- 9 ment not more than two years, or by fine not exceeding
- 10 five hundred dollars.'
