IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter three hundred and three of the
Public Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, relating
to Labor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Chapter three hundred and three of the Public Laws of
2 eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is hereby amended so
3 as to read as follows:

‘Any employer, employee, or other person who by
5 threats of injury, intimidation or force, alone or in combi-
6 nation with others, prevents any person from entering
7 into, continuing in, or leaving the employment of any
8 person, firm or corporation, shall be punished by impris-
9 ment not more than two years, or by fine not exceeding
10 five hundred dollars.’
