STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT for the better Protection of Timber Lands of this State.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Fish and game wardens are hereby made state 2 fire wardens, and it shall be their duty while in and 3 about the woods to caution all sportsmen of the 4 danger from fires in the woods, and to extinguish 5 all fires left burning by any one, if within their 6 power; and to give notice to any and all parties 7 interested, when possible, of fires raging and beyond 8 their control, to the end that the same may be con-9 trolled and extinguished.
