AN ACT to legalize the proceedings by which Camp Benson Grand Army of the Republic Association was organized.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The proceedings by which Camp Benson Grand 2 Army of the Republic Association of Maine was 3 organized at Newport on the twelfth (12th) of 4 September eighteen hundred and eighty-seven are 5 hereby confirmed, and the organization is hereby 6 declared legal and valid.
