AN ACT to amend section 15 of chapter 141 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to Houses of Correction.

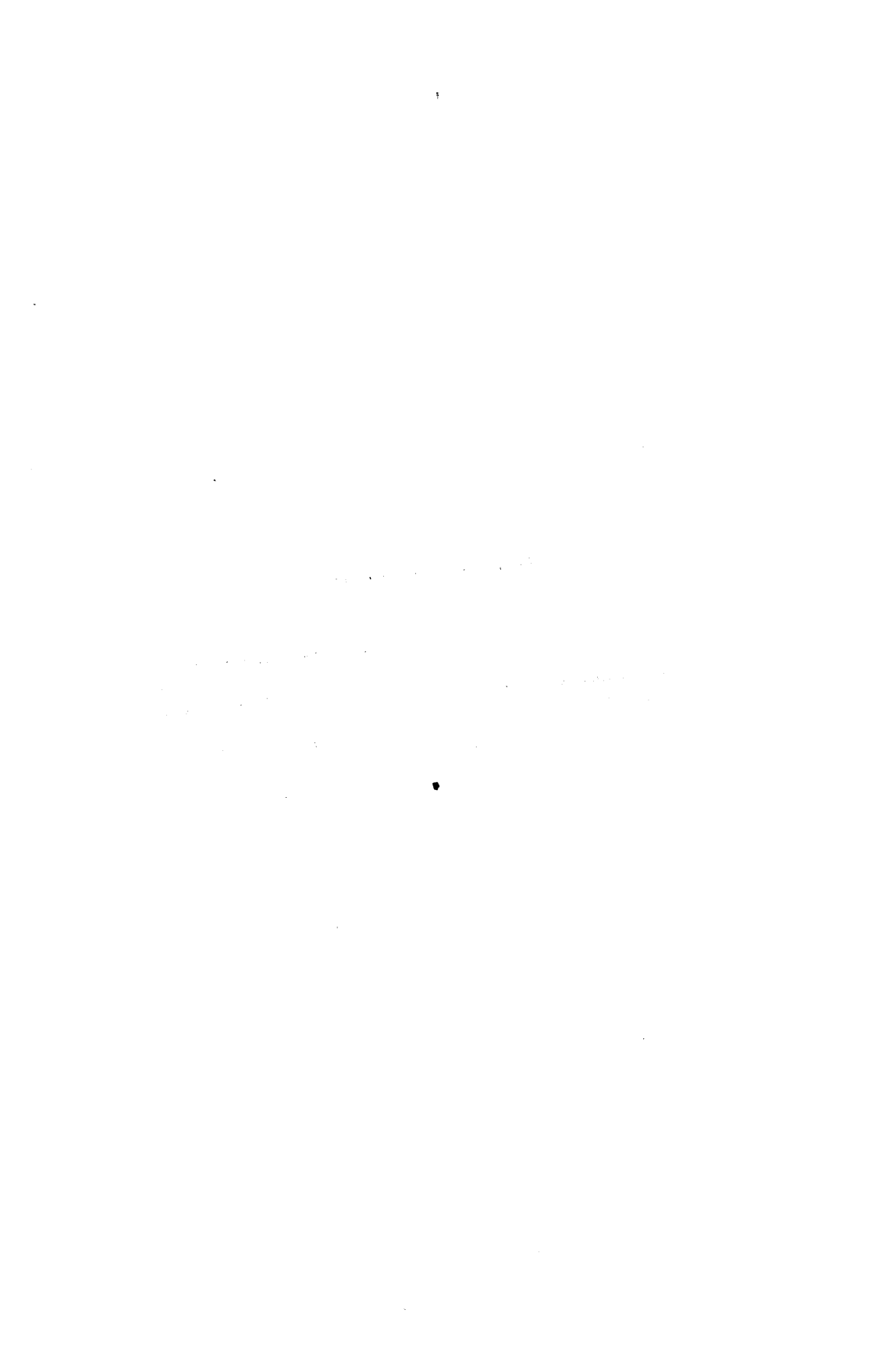
*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. Section 15 of chapter 141, Revised Statutes,
2 is hereby amended so that it shall read as follows :

‘Section 15. A town, at its own expense, may build
4 and maintain a house of correction, or may appropriate
5 for such purpose, in part or in whole, any workhouse
6 owned by the town ; and any person belonging to or found
7 in such town, liable to be sent by a trial justice to the
8 county house of correction, may be sent to such town
9 house by any justice of such town, and by the like pro-
10 cess ; but this section shall not restrain such justice from

11 committing any person so liable to the county house of
12 correction; and the respondent may appeal as in other
13 cases, *provided*, that cities and towns maintaining a house
14 of correction shall receive from the county the same com-
15 pensation per week for board and maintenance of such
16 prisoners as is allowed for board of prisoners in jail.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
