RESOLVE authorizing the State Librarian to enter into contracts for furnishing the new Library Rooms.

Resolved, That the state librarian, under the 2 supervision of the governor and council, be and 3 hereby is authorized to enter into the proper con-4 tracts for furnishing the new library rooms in a 5 proper manner with book-stacks, shelvings, cases 6 and furniture, and for such purpose the sum of eight 7 thousand five hundred dollars is hereby approprise ated.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

To Accompany House Document No. 291.

First. We find that it will require twenty-two stacks for book shelving, with one inch steel uprights, with iron cross supports, and best white pine shelving.

Second. We find that it will require for furnishings:

- 1 oak book case for first floor, east side, 20 feet in length.
- 1 oak book case for first floor, west side, 13 feet in length.
- 1 oak book and map case for first floor.
- I oak circular case for first floor, newspapers, south bay.
- 5 oak window cases for first floor.
- 1 oak book case for first floor, S. E. corner.
- 1 oak book case for second floor, east side, 19 feet in length.
- 1 oak book case for second floor, west side, 13 feet in length.
- 1 oak book case, private, 14 feet in length.
- 6 oak tables, 3 feet, 6 inches, by 6 feet.
- 1 oak table, 2 feet, 6 inches, by 9 feet.
- 36 oak chairs, leather seat and back as per sketch.
 - 4 oak stools, leather seat and back.
 - 6 S. S. oak chairs, leather seat and back.
 - 4 oak chairs, leather seat and back.
 - 1 oak easy chair.
 - 1 oak lounge.
 - 2 oak 5-feet roll top desks, with top cases.
- 202 yards Axminster carpet for three rooms made and laid.
- 125 rubber matting.
- 36 rollers for maps.
- 25 yards curtain goods, for two cases, rods and making.
 - 2 patent rockers, in leather, for library.
 - 4 window shelves for law library.
 - 6 chairs for law library.
 - 1 letter press stand.
