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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED  
AND NINETY-ONE.

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AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred seventy-nine of the  
Public Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine, relating to  
the Bureau of Industrial and Labor Statistics.

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*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Section four of chapter 279 of the public laws of eighteen  
2 hundred eighty-nine is hereby amended by striking out in  
3 the fifth line the words "fifteen hundred," and substituting  
4 the words 'two thousand,' so that said section as amended  
5 shall read as follows:

'Section 4. The commissioner herein named, shall  
7 receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, and to  
8 aid in carrying out the provisions of this act, said com-  
9 missioner is hereby authorized to employ such assistance

10 and incur such expense, not exceeding two thousand dol-  
11 lars per annum, as shall be necessary to carry out the  
12 provisions of this act.'

Section seven of said chapter is hereby amended by  
14 striking out in the second line the word "six" and substi-  
15 tuting the word 'seven,' so that said section as amended  
16 shall read as follows :

'Section 7. There is hereby appropriated out of any  
18 money remaining in the state treasury the sum of seven  
19 thousand dollars for the ensuing two years for the purpose  
20 of carrying out the provisions of this act; the commis-  
21 sioner herein named shall receive his salary in quarterly  
22 instalments, and the expenses of the bureau shall be paid  
23 on the vouchers presented by the commissioner, after the  
24 same shall have been audited and approved by the  
25 governor and council.'
