## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT to amend chapter two hundred seventy-nine of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred eighty-nine, relating to the Bureau of Industrial and Labor Statistics.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section four of chapter 279 of the public laws of eighteen

- 2 hundred eighty-nine is hereby amended by striking out in
- 3 the fifth line the words "fifteen hundred," and substituting
- 4 the words 'two thousand,' so that said section as amended
- 5 shall read as follows:

'Section 4. The commissioner herein named, shall

- 7 receive an annual salary of fifteen hundred dollars, and to
- 8 aid in carrying out the provisions of this act, said com-
- 9 missioner is hereby authorized to employ such assistance

- 10 and incur such expense, not exceeding two thousand dol-
- 11 lars per annum, as shall be necessary to carry out the
- 12 provisions of this act.'

Section seven of said chapter is hereby amended by

- 14 striking out in the second line the word "six" and substi-
- 15 tuting the word 'seven,' so that said section as amended
- 16 shall read as follows:

'Section 7. There is hereby appropriated out of any

- 18 money remaining in the state treasury the sum of seven
- 19 thousand dollars for the ensuing two years for the purpose
- 20 of carrying out the provisions of this act; the commis-
- 21 sioner herein named shall receive his salary in quarterly
- 22 instalments, and the expenses of the bureau shall be paid
- 23 on the vouchers presented by the commissioner, after the
- 24 same shall have been audited and approved by the
- 25 governor and council.'
