STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED
AND NINETY-ONE.

AN ACT with reference to Religious Instruction in
the Maine State Reform School.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECTION 1. The governor and council are hereby
2 authorized to arrange for such religious instruction
3 and services for the inmates of the Maine State
4 Reform School as they may deem expedient.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
