STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY SENATE DOCUMENT No. 162.

It is estimated that the current expenses for 1891, including mechanical school and new cottage will be.... \$18,000 00

For ordinary repairs.....	2,000 00
For furnishing new cottage.....	2,500 00
Steam heating and plumbing.....	2,500 00

	\$24,000 00

The steam heating and plumbing cost \$2,500, but \$1,000 of this amount has been paid out of the general funds of the school, with the expectation that it would be refunded. That is the school advanced \$1,000 out of the money on which it depended to pay current expenses, and if that amount is not refunded it will not have sufficient funds to pay current expenses already incurred.

For ordinary repairs	2,000 00
