STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing clerk hire for the Bank
Examiner.

Resolved, The Bank Examiner is hereby author-
2 ized and empowered or clerks to assist in the
3 discharge of the duties of his office whenever the
4 exigencies require such assistance; provided, how-
5 ever, that the expense to the State for such clerk
6 hire shall not exceed the sum of one thousand dol-
7 lars in any one year, and the same amount shall be
8 appropriated annually for such purpose.

Resolved, All prior resolves inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.

The chartering of new corporations and other acts of the legislature since the clerk hire for the bank examiner was established in 1887, have largely increased the work of this office and render the proposed increase of clerk hire necessary.
